- **EASTER VIGIL:** Bishop Jensen reminds us that the Church teaches [(Paschalis Sollemnitatis, 1988), also found in (Ordo for 2016-2017 p.202 Easter Triduum Notes 1 & 2)]
 - "(78) The entire celebration of the Easter Vigil takes place at night. It should not begin before nightfall; it should end before daybreak on Sunday. This rule is to be taken according to its strictest sense. Reprehensible are those abuses and practices which have crept into many places in violation of this ruling, whereby the Easter Vigil is celebrated at the time of day that is customary to celebrate anticipated Sunday Mass."
 - "(80) From the very outset the Church has celebrated that annual Pasch, which is solemnity of solemnities, above all by means of a night vigil..."

Priests in the diocese are asked to celebrate Easter Vigil no earlier than 8:30 PM.
