This exciting and dynamic program is being offered to high school teens and their parents every Wednesday evening for 10 weeks from 700 - 8:30 PM starting on March 29, 2017 at the Domano Renewal Centre, facilitated by Fr. Basil Burns and Claudia Betz.

This will give teens the answers and tools needed to successfully and safely navigate through life. It will also provide parents with family applications to help create and foster a *Theology of the Body* culture in the home.

The cost for material is \$30/participant guide and \$15/parent guide (optional). The use of the facility is by donation.
