- 2. \*\*UPDATE: CALLED TOGETHER GIVING, SHARING, SERVING As of November 7, Called Together - Giving, Sharing, Serving has reached 72.67% of the Diocesan goal in pledges, for a total of \$290,678. It is good news that all parishes have remitted their pledge reports to date.
  - St. Andrew's Parish joins St. Patrick's Parish, McBride and St. Mary's Parish, PG in reaching and surpassing their parish goal. St. Andrew's is at 102.34% of their parish goal. We thank Fr. Vince James, OMI, the Parish Leadership Team, and the parishioners for their commitment to Called Together.

3. \*\*CHEQUES PAYABLE TO PARISHES AND SCHOOLS: A few weeks ago we asked that the Called Together/Appeal cheques be made payable to RCEC – Appeal OR RCEC – Called Together. We received the following direction from our banking institution to make this request, not only for cheques payable to the Appeal, but for ALL cheques payable to the diocese, schools and parishes.

"The Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Prince Rupert (RCEC) is the legal name that all accounts with the banks are setup under. We identify each of those accounts with a 'short name' or 'nickname' however, legally any cheques received for deposit for each of these individual accounts should be made payable to the legal name RCEC and not the names of the individual parishes or schools. We realize that for many years each location has been depositing cheques payable to the individual parish without issue. It is important to note that procedure around the acceptance of payments has changed over these years as well. RBC's policy requires you to operate the bank account(s) under your legally registered name. This includes the acceptance of payment to be deposited to your account(s)."

Hence, we are asking that you pass on this request to parishes and schools. ALL cheques should be made payable to **RCEC** – **Your parish name or school**, or **RCEC** with a notation in the memo section with the name of the parish or school.

Cheques not made out to the legal name may result in the cheque(s) being returned with bank services charges being charged.
