



Sister Jude died on Tuesday, November 14, 2017, at the Dominican Life Center in Adrian, MI. She was 78 years of age and in the 59th year of her religious profession in the Adrian Dominican Congregation. Sister Jude ministered in elementary education and in a variety of pastoral ministries in the USA.

the life of St. Joseph's Parish, Smithers undertaking many roles. She was honoured to sit with the Beaver Clan in Moricetown. She carried out a variety of volunteer ministries and frequently shared in Feasts and Celebrations in Hazelton.
