

2. *APRIL 2 IS THE ANNIVERSARY OF EPISCOPAL ORDINATION OF OUR BISHOP, MOST REVEREND STEPHEN JENSEN (2013): This is a diocesan celebration (please see ORDO Pastoral Note 25a, p. 50). Since this year the 2nd of April falls on the Octave of Easter, it is the Solemnity of the day that will be celebrated. Pastors, with their parishioners, are requested to offer Mass using the prayers in the Roman Missal (Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions, I. For Holy Church, 3. For the Bishop, p. 1236-1237) for the Bishop's intention.

Bishop Stephen Jensen will celebrate the 12:10 PM Mass at Sacred Heart Cathedral on that day with the priests of the Central Deanery concelebrating. All are invited to come and celebrate with our shepherd.

Please include the following prayer in the parish Universal Prayers on the anniversary date, Monday, April 2, and on Sunday, April 8, the Second Sunday of Easter.

"We celebrate the anniversary of the ordination of our Bishop Stephen Jensen; may God send the Holy Spirit to guide him and all the people of our diocese in following Christ our Lord."


DYC 2018-"IN THE BEGINNING" IS FAST APPROACHING! It will be held on APRIL 20 – 22, 2018!!
