

First Nations Retreat
April 20-22, 2012

A retreat week-end for First Nations will be held at the Domano Renewal Centre beginning with supper on Friday, April 20, and ending with lunch on Sunday, April 22, 2012.

The title of the retreat is “People of the Beatitudes - People of Blessings.” The process includes presentations, time for prayer, ritual, quiet time and opportunity for sharing. Saturday evening will have some time for socializing and drumming.

The presenter is Fr. Vince LaPlante, OMI from Vancouver. Fr. Vince is familiar with this area since he was pastor in Fort St. James (1971-72) and administrator of Lejac Residential School (1972-74). He was also pastor in Dawson Creek, Ucluelet and Tofino on Vancouver Island and of the Squamish First Nation in St. Paul’s Parish, North Vancouver. Fr. Vince got to know many First Nations people in the places in which he lived. He has participated in several healing circles and sessions. He is looking forward to leading this retreat.

Please note that this program has been subsidized, therefore it is possible to offer it at a reduced cost of \$100.00 per person. This includes overnight accommodations and meals.
