ST. PATRICK'S PARISH, MCBRIDE

As families gathered on Thanksgiving Weekend to offer gratitude to God for the many blessings they have received, it is also an opportune time for us to offer thanks and appreciation for the assistance that the Diocesan Annual Appeal has annually given St. Patrick's Parish.

St. Patrick's Parish is located in McBride approximately 210km east of Prince George. With no current industry in the community, the population of McBride is shrinking as families relocate to find employment. This has a great impact on the parish. A majority of parishioners are seniors who for many years have shared their time, talent and treasure to support their parish and whose commitment has ensured that the Church doors remain open.

The Church and Rectory are 75 years old and, are in need of constant maintenance. This small parish community strives to support itself through Sunday donations, fundraising events and by doing as much of our own maintenance as possible.

St. Patrick's Parish benefits directly from the Diocesan Annual Appeal as the subsidy it receives contributes towards paying the heating and electricity bills, and the travel expenses for a priest to celebrate Mass at St. Patrick's twice a month. It is also probable that without this subsidy there would not be a resident Pastoral Life Director in the parish. 
DIOCESAN ANNUAL APPEAL
