1. Halloween Fundraising and UNICEF

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops recommends that Canadian Dioceses and Catholic Schools use only Catholic charitable organizations - specifically the Holy Childhood Association and the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace - as recipients of Halloween fundraising projects by children. The CCCB no longer proposes UNICEF as a third option because of its collaboration with the United Nations Population Fund which publicly promotes sexual and reproductive rights including abortion and artificial contraception.
