POSITION: Diocesan Youth and Young Adult Ministry Coordinator

HOURS: 35 hours per week

ACCOUNTABLITY:

Reports directly to the Director of Formation Services; collaborates with other personnel in the Pastoral Centre when needed.

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF MINISTRY:

This ministry is primarily indirect services (supporting parishes in serving youth and young adults); some direct service is also involved.

MAJOR AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

- 1) Coordination
 - Promoting the Diocesan vision of ministry to youth and young adults, which is based on *Renewing the Vision: A Framework for Catholic Youth Ministry.*
 - Surveying and evaluating parish youth and young adult ministry needs on an ongoing basis
 - Developing effective networking and communication strategies
 - Establishing a Diocesan Youth and Young Adult Advisory Council
 - Organizing a limited number of regional and diocesan events, such as retreats, leadership training and the Diocesan Youth Conference
 - Producing a newsletter for youth and young adults of the Diocese
 - Preparing a Youth Ministry budget

- 2) Consultation
 - With parish leadership to facilitate the implementation of comprehensive youth and young adult ministry
 - Collaborating with diocesan staff on the Diocesan Assembly, lay formation and catechetical workshops as time and circumstances permit
- 3) Training
 - Providing formation in ministry, youth ministry theory and youth ministry skills through training sessions, workshops and a newsletter
- 4) Resourcing
 - Maintaining information on youth and young adult ministry resources, programs, conferences and events
 - Networking with the National Office of Religious Education and the Western Canadian Association of Catholic Youth Ministers to keep abreast of guidelines, developments and resources
 - Attending one or two professional development events a year
