1. Fr. Nicholas Forde, OMI

We pray for the repose of the soul of Father Nicholas Forde, OMI, who died in Prince George on Friday, June 13th at the age of 81 years. Father Forde was born in Cardiff, Wales and ordained to the priesthood in the Congregation of Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate by Most Rev. Fergus O'Grady, OMI, in Kilkenny, Ireland on March 16, 1957. In 1977 he came to the Diocese of Prince George to work in Catholic Education with Bishop O'Grady and the Frontier Apostolate. He served as pastor of Immaculate Conception Parish in Prince George for 18 years. A prayer service for Father Forde will be held on Friday, June 20th at 7 pm at Immaculate Conception Parish and the Funeral Mass will take place on Saturday, June 21st at 11 am at Sacred Heart Cathedral.
