The Pastoral Challenges of the Family in the Context of Evangelization *Instrumentum Laboris*

Instrumentum Laboris is the result of the consultation of the III Extraordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops on "The Pastoral Challenges of the Family in the Context of Evangelization" which was held in the fall 2013. The work of the Synod of Bishops is to take place in two stages. First, in 2014, the Synod Fathers will analyze the information, testimonies and recommendations. Following that, in 2015, they will further reflect on the highlighted points to formulate pastoral guidelines. This is by no means an exhaustive document, but *Instrumentum Laboris* offers "perspective on the present-day situation of the family, on the challenges of the family and on the reflections related to the family today".
