#### <u>Overview</u>

This **course, released in summer 2009**, was developed through IPNRC, now part of the Church Health Center in Memphis, TN. Faith community nursing/FCN (also called parish nursing), is an ANA-recognized nursing specialty. Faith community nursing is unique because it unites intentional care of the body, mind, and spirit.

Those who are not RNs, but have an interest in caring for the mind, body and spirit, can attend this training to become a Health Minister. RNs that do not have a faith or spiritual community will learn how to develop their nursing practice to include care of a client's spiritual needs in any setting.
