As a result, we are now close to 50% of our Diocesan Goal. Congratulations to Father Vince James, OMI and St. Andrew's Parish in Fraser Lake for going over their parish goal consistently in all 8 years of the Appeal! This year they reached 102.2%!

To date another six parishes are over 50% of their Parish Goal: St. Patrick's Parish, McBride; Christ Our Savior Parish, Prince George; St. Joseph's Parish, Smithers; Sacred Heart Parish, Terrace; Immaculate Conception Parish, Prince George and Notre Dame Parish, Dawson Creek.
