Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms

As assisted suicide is introduced in Canada, the conscience rights of individuals and institutions must be protected.

The Government of Canada is now drafting assisted-suicide legislation. It is essential that the law include conscience protections to ensure that individuals who ethically cannot participate in assisted suicide suffer no harm to their career or any other form of discrimination.

No Postage Necessary

I call on the Federal Government to ensure that laws and regulations that govern access to assisted suicide protect the conscience rights of individuals and institutions that ethically cannot participate in an individual's suicide.
