Great news from the Appeal Office!

Reaching out in Mercy has reached **75.8%** or \$303,022.00 of its total in pledges, coming from **1022** donors across our Diocese.

In addition to Immaculate Conception Parish, that surpassed its goal last week, three other parishes have met and surpassed their goal this week, namely: St. Mary's Parish (103%), St. Patrick's Parish (109.1%), and St. Andrew's Parish (107.7%).

Thank you to Fr. Gilbert Bertrand OMI, Fr. John Garden and Detta Smith, Fr. Vince James OMI, and their respective Parish Leadership Teams and Appeal Coordinators for working hard to promote the Appeal.

7. 200 YEARS OF OBLATES— **DECEMBER 8, 2016** - The missionary adventure of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate began with Saint Eugene de Mazenod who, on 25 January 1816, gathered in the former Carmelite convent of Aix a group of priests to evangelize Provence. Today, Oblates count nearly 3800 men and are present in sixty-five countries.

Prince George Diocese is one of the many dioceses that the Oblates continue to serve. To celebrate the Oblate bicentennial in our diocese there will be Mass on December 8, 2016 on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception at 7:00 PM at Sacred Heart Cathedral. Bishop Jensen will be the main celebrant along with Oblate priests and other clergy in the diocese.

City parishes are asked not to schedule an evening Mass on that day, but invite parishioners to come to the celebration at the cathedral. A reception will follow the Mass.
