This will include activities and presentations relating to Development and Peace and our partners, international development, the essential role of women in the global south, and climate change
- 2. We will explore and answer the question: "Why do we, as Catholics, have a responsibility to ensure that creation and those most vulnerable are cared for?" This will be accomplished primarily through an examination of *Catholic Social Teaching* the Church's doctrines on issues relating to social justice as well as moments of spiritual reflection.
- 3. To equip participants with the tools, skills and resources necessary to become more effective leaders and advocates for social change. Following the retreat, participants will be encouraged take on a youth leadership role in order to help grow the Development and Peace youth movement in their parish, school, community and/or diocese.

These objectives will be accomplished through a variety of presentations, guest speakers, discussions, debates, group activities, spiritual reflection and the creation of a more unified, informed youth presence in our region.
