8. UPDATE ON DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE

With the help of the Canadian bishops' conference, the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace (CCODP) is now addressing serious problems that have been identified with some of its partner organizations involving activities contrary to Catholic moral teaching.
