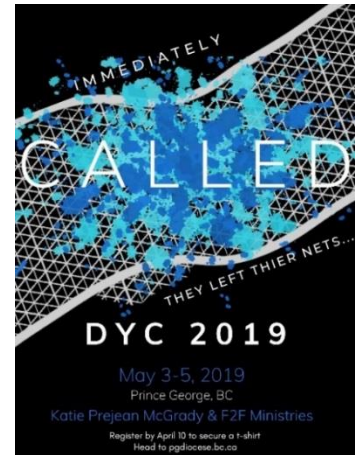
This year's DYC is excited to have Katie Prejean McGrady as the keynote speaker along with Face2Face Ministries.
