

**UPDATE ON PASTORAL CENTRE PROPERTY:** In February of this year, Bishop Jensen announced that the diocese had received an offer to purchase the land on which the Pastoral Centre stands. After an extensive consultation process required by the Church's canon law, an Agreement of Sale was signed.

There were numerous subjects placed by the diocese and the purchaser. Once these conditions were met, the sale would be finalized. However, the purchaser did not meet its own self-imposed conditions within the timeframe specified, so the sale will not proceed.


