4. **HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION:** "On Sundays and other holydays of obligation, the faithful are obliged to participate in the Mass. They are also to abstain from work or business that would inhibit the worship to be given to God, the joy proper to the Lord's Day, or the due relaxation of mind and body." (Can. 1247)

In Canada there are two holydays of obligation:

- January 1, Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God
- December 25, Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord (Christmas)


13. **SIMBANG GABI (FILIPINO "NIGHT MASS")** A novena of Masses in preparation for Christmas, traditional in Filipino culture.


