

The Season of Lent



The season of prayer and penance to prepare for the feast of the Resurrection begins on Ash Wednesday, February 26, 2020. Originally the period of fasting in preparation for Easter did not exceed two or three days, but by the time of the Council of Nicaea in AD 325 forty days were customary. This length of time is associated with Christ's forty-day fast in the desert before beginning His public life (Matthew 4:1-2) and also recalls the forty years Israel spent in

the desert after the Exodus from Egypt (Numbers 14:34).

Lent has a twofold purpose: it is the last stage of preparation of Catechumens for Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil and it prepares all of us to renew our baptismal promises at Easter.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are universal days of penance. On these days those who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from meat and those from 18 to 59 years of age should also fast, limiting their food to not more than one regular meal and two lighter snacks.

Besides fast and abstinence on specified days, the whole Lenten season should be penitential, with stress on prayer, reception of the Sacraments, especially Penance and Reconciliation, almsgiving and the practice of charity.

"What every Christian should always be doing must now be performed more earnestly and devoutly...not simply a reduction in our food, but the elimination of our evil habits" (St. Leo the Great).

- 2. *CATECHESIS ON THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE AND RECONCILIATION: For four consecutive Fridays during Lent (March 6, 13, 20, and 27) before praying the Stations of the Cross, Fr. Rector will provide Catechesis on the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation at Sacred Heart Cathedral. The catechesis will start at 6:30 PM. The Stations of the Cross will begin at 7:00 PM. Please come and learn more about the Sacrament.
- 3. *The Rite of Election and Call to Lenten Renewal in the city parishes will be celebrated at Sacred Heart Cathedral on the First Sunday of Lent, March 1, 2020, at 2:00 PM with Bishop Jensen. There are three Catechumens (1 from Sacred Heart Cathedral, 1 from St. Mary's Parish and 1 from Immaculate Conception Parish) and four Candidates (1 Christ Our Saviour Parish; 2 St. Mary's Parish and 1 Immaculate Conception Parish) who are preparing for full initiation in the Church this coming Easter. Let's support them and include them in our prayers.
- 4. **SHARE LENT COLLECTION 2020 The Canadian bishops' conference is close to concluding the work of addressing issues with the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace.



In the light of this progress, the annual Share Lent collection is authorized in the diocese this year.

During this year's Lent, navigate the Amazon River to learn, reflect, pray and act throughout Lent, in solidarity with the peoples of the Amazon and the Earth, our common home.

We are told that the best we can hope for at this stage is that the Federal Government carry out further consultation. Given time constraints, electronic mail (rather than a written letter sent by regular mail) can also be effective.
