Advice from the Saints on

St. Teresa of Avila wrote in *The Way of Perfection*: "When you do not receive communion and you do not attend Mass, you can make a spiritual communion, which



is a most beneficial practice; by it the love of God will be greatly impressed on you."

St. Jean Vianney said: "If we are deprived of Sacramental Communion, let us replace it, as far as we can, by spiritual communion, which we can make every moment; for we ought to have always a burning desire to receive the good God. Communion is to the soul like blowing a fire that is beginning to go out, but that has still plenty of hot embers; we blow, and the fire burns again."

St. Thomas Aquinas distinguished the physical and spiritual reception of the Eucharist, and described Spiritual Communion as, "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the most holy sacrament and lovingly embrace him".

St. Leonard of Port Maurice said: "If you practice the holy exercise of spiritual Communion several times each day, within a month you will see your heart completely changed."

Benedict XVI recommended making Spiritual Communions in *Sacramentum caritatis*: "Even in cases where it is not possible to receive sacramental communion, participation at Mass remains necessary, important, meaningful and fruitful. In such circumstances it is beneficial to cultivate a desire for full union with Christ through the practice of spiritual communion, praised by Pope John Paul II and recommended by saints who were masters of the spiritual life".



1. PREPARING TO CELEBRATE HOLY WEEK AND EASTER AT HOME: To help parishioners observe Holy Week and celebrate Easter in their homes, Fr. Rector Tolentino, Rector of Sacred Heart Cathedral, will be presenting on the topic: "Preparing to Celebrate Holy Week and Easter at HOME" via LIVESTREAM via Sacred Heart Cathedral Prince George, Facebook page.

In this presentation, there will be an explanation of the liturgical celebrations from Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion to the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night. In the presentation suggestions

5. MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE RABINO VISITING THE SICK AND THE HOSPITAL:

To keep patients, families and staff safe and in keeping with the Provincial Health officer's recommendation for social distancing, Northern Health is limiting the number of visitors entering the hospital effective March 17, 2020.

Until further notice, the following visitor restrictions are in place in Northern Health facilities:

- Hospital Emergency Dept. (ER), Intensive Care Unit (ICU) Critical Care areas:
 - ONE adult caregiver/support person
- Palliative Care will accommodate patient and family needs and consult with infection prevention and control.
- No visitor with a fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat or diarrhea may visit any of the above facilities.

Visit to the sick, Holy Communion and Anointing of the Sick will be accommodated upon request. I appeal to my brother priests to be available to visit sick parishioners, anoint them if needed and give them Holy Communion.
