

1. NEW BUSINESS MANAGER FOR THE DIOCESE: The diocese has successfully concluded the search for a replacement for Lynn Monteith, who will retire soon.

Mr. James Fowlie, a member of the cathedral parish, has been appointed Business Manager for the diocese, coming to this new role from a similar position with a large law firm in Prince George. He will assume the broad management duties that John Philips and Lynn Monteith shared, as well as additional duties, including IT management and communications and administration of the safe environment program.

The financial reporting for the diocese will be outsourced to a company that already does this work for the CISPG.

Tickets are available from Tuesday mornings until Saturday at 11:00AM.


