Thank you to those who made contributions this past week. We didn't make even a tiny dent in the Diocesan Goal, but we did manage to add some more to the parish rebates destined for special parish goals and projects throughout the Diocese. With all of the challenges of this past week, it's not unexpected. Hopefully we will see things improve soon.

*I wanted to note that St. Patrick's has hit over 450% of their parish goal!* They were surprised with some unexpected and costly repairs and are planning to use their rebate to cover those expenses.

None of our parishes under their goal made any progress this past week. Some are so very close and we hope that some extra effort will help get them on track.

I continue to receive some inquiries from parishes wishing to help out more by setting aside monies from their rebate. Please feel free to reach out if you would like to help.

## Insurance Update for Parishes and Schools

Parishes and Schools are reminded that the Arson Risk and Water Damage Prevention forms are due back to Zealline Sadiwa <u>zsadiwa@pgdiocese.bc.ca</u> by **November 30<sup>th</sup>**.

Invoices for insurance for the 2020-2021 insurance year are being sent out immediately to the Pastors, Pastoral Life Directors, and Principals. 
#### Free Online Presentation on Palliative Care
