## Extension of COVID restrictions



### Annual Diocesan Appeal Update

I am pleased to report that we are almost at 95% of our Diocesan goal! In addition, St. Andrew's in Fraser Lake has met its parish goal and Church of the Resurrection Parish in Fort St. John is only \$150 away from reaching their goal. Well done both of you! This means that 15 of the 20 parishes have essentially met their goal, and we're hoping to see the remaining five hit their targets soon.

Some of our other parishes have continued to add to their parish total over the Christmas season. Again, if parishes wish to commit some of those funds to help support the smaller parishes and missions of the Diocese, please feel free to reach out to me. In addition, I am so pleased that many of our pledges have already been received, with less than 10% as of yet unreceived.
