# **Called Together Update**

We continue to have a few donations trickle in, for which we are very grateful.

A reminder that the Diocesan Annual Appeal will conclude the 2020-2021 appeal year on June 30, 2021. All donations received after that date will be credited to the 2021-2022 appeal year. The "active phase" of the next appeal will not begin until September, however.
