

B.C. Bishops' appeal in support of Healing & Reconciliation



The Catholic bishops of British Columbia recognize the need for a province-wide initiative to raise funds to support healing and reconciliation among Indigenous and non-Indigenous people. In the Diocese of Prince George, this appeal will run concurrently with the Diocesan Annual Appeal but remain independent.

The goal of the Campaign is to support residential school survivors and Indigenous communities in our diocese through projects that promote healing and reconciliation as part of our ongoing response to the recommendations of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action.

The Healing and Reconciliation appeal does not have a target, but looks to the generosity of everyone to make a meaningful contribution to promote this important work. In prior years, the diocese has tried to meet this need through programs such as Returning to Spirit, the Rose Prince Pilgrimage and through the work of our priests and religious involved in indigenous ministry.

The bishops of British Columbia sincerely hope that this Campaign will help to restore trust and further the ongoing journey to truth and reconciliation.
