Bishops' Campaign for Healing and Reconciliation

Our Diocese will conduct the Diocesan Appeal and the Bishops' of BC of Healing and Reconciliation Campaign simultaneously and as separate collections. The goal of the Bishop's Appeal for Healing and Reconciliation is to support residential school survivors and Indigenous communities in our province. Unlike the Diocesan Appeal, the Healing and Reconciliation is not an annual collection and will only be repeated if deemed necessary to continue this important work. It is our sincere hope that the Healing and Reconciliation Campaign will help to restore trust and further the ongoing journey to truth and healing.

2021-2022 Diocesan Annual Appeal and Healing and Reconciliation Appeal

September 25/26 is the *Called Together* Educational and Promotional Weekend as well as the continuation of the Healing and Reconciliation Appeal.

This week we are asking the pastors to have some prepared personal testimony about the benefits of the Diocesan Appeal in our diocese. The instructions for Week #2 of the Appeals are attached. Materials such as pledge forms and the brochure continue to be available in the September 15th Wednesday weekly on the diocesan webpage.

Please remember that we have only a three-week active phase for the Appeal this year and October 2/3 is Commitment Weekend. To ensure everyone receives their appeal packages by Commitment Weekend please mail out any unclaimed addressed Appeal envelopes early next week.
