Please include the following information in your bulletins so that donors know what we need from them for electronic donations:

One change on Canada Helps is that there are two Appeal options – one for Called Together and one for the Healing and Reconciliation Appeal.

We also ask that donors use the message box in Canada Helps and Interac eTransfer to indicate four things:

1. **Which parish should be credited for their Called Together donation;**
2. **How much of their donation is going to Called Together and how much is going to the Healing and Reconciliation appeal;**
3. **Their donor number from their Called Together envelope, if possible; and**
4. **An email address so that we can reach them with any questions.**
