Donation Reminder for Parishes

A reminder to all Parishes: please ensure all donations are clearly marked with the year which they were received so they can be receipted in the correct year.

Donations received before the start of 2022 are considered to have been received in the 2021 tax year, even if the funds are not deposited until 2022.

Donations received via mail and which are postmarked in 2021 or are reasonably understood to have been donated in the current tax year can be receipted into 2021 even if they don’t arrive in the mail until 2022, so long as it is within a reasonable time frame.
