Rescheduled Dates Announced for the Indigenous Delegation to Rome

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has announced that the Indigenous Delegation to Rome has been rescheduled to the end of March and beginning of April. The Delegation was originally scheduled for December but was postponed due to the evolving situation with the Omicron variant.

Pope Francis is now scheduled to meet with the delegates during the week of March 28th, with a final audience for all participants to take place on April 1, 2022.

Canada's Bishops Announce Indigenous Reconciliation Fund to Support Projects Across Canada

Canada's Catholic Bishops have announced that they will be establishing a new registered charity to manage the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund. The Fund will accept contributions from 73 dioceses across Canada.

The fund will be subject to an audit by an independent accounting firm and publish annual reports each year.
