# Indigenous Reconciliation Fund Board of Directors Reports Progress on \$30 Million National Fundraising Commitment

The Indigenous Reconciliation Fund has announced that it is now accepting proposals and distributing funds in support of healing and reconciliation with Indigenous peoples. On September 30, 2021, the Canadian Bishops announced a national financial pledge of \$30 million, to be raised over the next 5 years. Of that \$30 million, \$4.6 million has already been collected by the Fund from Catholic dioceses across Canada.

The Board of Directors for the Fund is made up of Indigenous leaders from across Canada, and projects are determined in consultation with First Nations, Métis, and Inuit Peoples on a local level. The first proposal received approval on July 15, 2022.
