During their National Plenary Assembly in the fall, the Bishops will be reviewing an updated action plan informed by the calls they have heard from our Indigenous brothers and sisters. It is their hope that the relationships built during the planning for Pope Francis’ visit will continue to grow and become the foundation for the work that lies ahead.

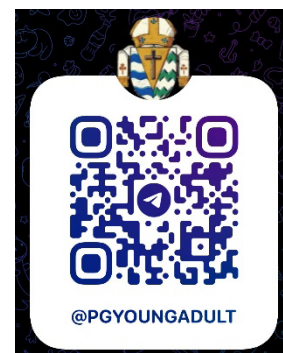
