#### Called Together and Healing and Reconciliation Appeals

A big thank you to everyone for your participation in the active phase of this year's appeals. We have had a good start, but there's still a long way to go.

As our active phase is shorter than usual, I would ask pastors to continue to support these appeal efforts at your Sunday Masses.

We are currently at just under 30% of our diocesan goal in pledges with nearly 25% received. We've also received almost \$12,000 in pledges and over \$9,000 received toward the Healing and Reconciliation appeal.

St. Patrick's (McBride) will soon hit their parish goal, having reached almost 80%, while St. Mary's (PG) is already over 70%. Sacred Heart Cathedral has jumped from just over 8% to over 65%, and Annunciation is over 52% of its goal. I also note that many other parishes also made significant progress this week.

I would like to thank all those who have supported our appeals through financial contributions and through prayer. Your support helps so many people in our small parishes, missions and ministries throughout the diocese.

#### Death of Fr. Wieslaw Szatanski, OMI



It is with sadness that we announce the death of Fr. Wieslaw Szatanski, OMI. Fr. Wes' body was discovered late Friday evening on September 23, 2022 at the Oblate cottage in Canmore, AB.

Most recently, Fr. Wes was assigned to ministry in Enoch, AB., St. Mary's in Prince George, and Pandosy Residence in Vancouver. Before this, Wes worked for many years with Indigenous communities, in the diocese of Mackenzie Fort Smith.

# CNEWA Canada disbursements to Ukraine reach \$5.5 million CAD since the beginning of 2022

More than \$5.5 million CAD in emergency aid has been disbursed to Ukraine by the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA), reaching people in large cities as well as remote villages.

The significant generosity of Canadians has contributed to the funding of aid convoys, shelters for the displaced, hospitals, care for people with special needs, and has provided families with basic supplies.

As winter approaches and the war continues with a looming energy crisis in sight, the CNEWA remains focused on helping people affected by the war survive and reiterates its call for Canadians to continue supporting the people of Ukraine through these difficult times.
