A Note About Receiving Holy Communion

Since the beginning of the Covid-19 emergency, the distribution of Holy Communion under both species has been discontinued.

While the chalice is no longer offered at the time of Communion, the teaching of Faith known as the doctrine of Concomitance tells us that Christ is wholly present under each Eucharistic species. His body cannot be separated from blood, His human soul, His divine nature and divine personality. Hence, it is not necessary to receive from the chalice to be united to the Lord in Holy Communion.

For the same reason, those who are gluten-intolerant may receive from the chalice only, rather than the Host. Each priest can accommodate such requests.

The War in Ukraine: A Call to Prayer, Fasting, and Action

The Ukrainian Catholic Bishops of Canada have released a pastoral letter inviting the people to pray, fast and act in support of their brothers and sisters in Ukraine.

In particular, they invite the faithful to a 3-day fast from November 24 to November 26th 2022. These dates commemorate the Holodomor Ukrainian Famine of 1932 to 1933, when many Ukrainians, like those suffering from the war today, had no food.


