# Called Together and Healing and Reconciliation Appeals Update

I am happy to report that we've now surpassed three-quarters of our diocesan goal, having reached almost 77% pledged of which 71% of our goal has already been received. Over \$63,000 will be returned to parishes once those pledges are fulfilled.

We didn't have any additional parishes reach their goals over the past two weeks. However, St. Patrick's Parish in McBride continues to climb, having surpassed 200% of their goal. Immaculate Conception Parish in Prince George are just under 96% of the way to their goal, with Sacred Heart Parish in Terrace right behind at just under 93%. Notre Dame Parish in Dawson Creek leapt 23% to reach 68%. St. Andrew's Parish in Fraser Lake added a solid 15% and are almost at 58% of their goal. Immaculata Parish in Burns Lake jumped 10% and are nearly halfway to their parish goal. Well done, all of you.

Our Healing and Reconciliation appeal has now reached almost \$32,000 in pledges with approximately \$30,500 already received.

I want to thank everyone for their continued generous support of our smaller parishes, missions and ministries throughout the diocese. With the challenge of inflation hitting everyone, it can be more difficult to prioritize the needs of others. Please remember that these communities throughout Northern B.C. are also challenged by continually increasing costs and rely on your support more than ever. We continue to place our trust in the Lord and encourage everyone to continue to faithfully pray for the needs of everyone throughout the diocese.

# Fake Email Messages from the Bishop and Clergy of the Diocese

There have been reports from people receiving emails and text messages pretending to be sent by priests or the bishop and requesting assistance of some kind. Please DO NOT respond. Emails from the bishop would come from pgdiocese.bc.ca or pgdiocese.ca. While most fake messages have been from gmail.com accounts, there have been rare reports of some fake emails imitating legitimate email accounts.

Our advisors have told us that there are no steps we can take to prevent these messages from being sent. All we can do is advise everyone of the problem. If you receive an unexpected email claiming to be from the Bishop, Clergy, or any religious in the diocese and are not certain if it is legitimate, please call the Diocesan Pastoral Centre at 250-964-4424 or forward the email to the Pastoral Centre at reception@pgdiocese.bc.ca.
