## Stories from Chetwynd

### **CWL Craft Fair and Art Show**

For the first time since the pandemic started, the annual CWL Craft Fair and Art Show of Our Lady of Peace in Chetwynd returned on November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022 to great success.

Every year, there's a baking table, craft table, quilt raffle, and Pie and Tea. Over the years there has also been a fishing pond for kids, bottle table, Lucky 7 table, cake walk, arms length and many others.

Known for many years as the CWL Christmas Bazaar, the event was renamed to Craft Fair in 2018 to avoid confusion, as “bazaar” is synonymous with “flea market” in some countries. The same year, the event was opened up to vendors, allowing them to rent tables at the fair. This year, there were 6 vendors, the highest number to attend the event. Most of the vendors were regulars from the local farmer's market.

In addition to the regular raffle and craft tables, an art show was added to the lobby, featuring the work of 3 artists from the parish for viewing as attendees entered the market area.

The event was organized by the CWL and supported by volunteer time, donations of baking, craft items, and pie for the pie and tea table. More volunteers than were signed up to help showed up to set-up, work the event, and clean-up.

### **Wheelchair Donation**

Over the last year, Our Lady of Peace has wanted to acquire 2 wheelchairs for the church to assist parishioners who have a hard time walking. Recently, they contacted the Knights of Columbus in Fort St. John. Grand Knight John French showed up with a brand-new wheelchair for the parish on November 23, 2022.

On December 8th, 2022, the parish received a phone call from TLC Thrift Shop letting them know that a second-hand wheelchair had recently been given to them and offered to donate it to the parish.

### **Christmas Pancake Breakfast**

On December 11th, 2022, Our Lady of Peace held their annual Christmas celebration. While usually a potluck, this year it was a pancake breakfast which a group of parishioners cooked for everyone, filling the room with the aroma of fresh pancakes, eggs, and sausages, with fruit and whipping cream to help satisfy the holiday sweet tooth.

## **Children's Christmas Dinner at St. Mary's, Prince George**

On December 4<sup>th</sup> 2022, St. Mary's Parish in Prince George held a Children's Christmas Party and Pasta Dinner to help collect gifts for St. Vincent de Paul's annual Christmas baskets. The event was organized and held by the Knights of Columbus in the St. Mary's School Gym and made possible through many generous donations.

## **Pastoral Care Training Sessions**

The valuable and free Pastoral Care Outreach Training series will be offered online again this winter. Nine sessions will be held via Zoom on Saturday mornings from 9:30 – noon, starting on January 28, 2023, and running until April 1 (with no session on March 18 for Spring Break).

Participants who attend all sessions will receive a Certificate of Completion. Participants will require a phone number and email address, a computer, tablet or smartphone with speakers, microphone and webcam, a reliable Internet connection and access to Zoom.

Whether you are a member of your parish Pastoral Care Team, an Extraordinary Minister of Communion, a member of the Knights of Columbus, CWL or St. Vincent de Paul, clergy or religious, caring for a family member, or someone attending as a personal undertaking, this training program is important. It will show why those who visit the sick are unique and how they can offer more than a friendly visit – they can be the hands and face of Christ to others. Bishop Gary Gordon of the Diocese of Victoria feels “it is important to have parishioners trained at the ready to provide a caring and compassionate experience to those who are most in need.”
