

A Milestone in the Diocese's History – the Retirement of Fr. Frank Salmon and Departure of Sr. Divinia

At the middle of January, Fr. Frank Salmon, OMI will retire from Our Lady of the Snows parish in Fort St. James.

His departure marks the end of an era of more than one hundred years, as the Oblates of Mary Immaculate were the first evangelizers of this part of Canada and Oblate priests and brothers served in the parishes of the diocese in the century that followed. In saying farewell to Fr. Salmon, we salute the long line of his Oblate confreres who gave themselves in the service of God's people here.

Sister Divinia Pedro, CSJ, has worked alongside Fr. Salmon for years and she, too, will leave the diocese to return to her community, the Sisters of Saint Joseph of Toronto. We thank her for years of generous service in the diocese.

Fr. Punnaiah Nalaparaju (Fr. Raju), Assistant Pastor since last summer, will become Administrator of Our Lady of the Snows and its missions.

At 10:30 am on Sunday, January 15 Bishop Jensen will celebrate Mass in Our Lady of the Snows Church to recognize and bid farewell to Fr. Salmon and Sr. Divinia.
