APPLICATION PROCEDURES

All applications are to be made by the parish or school and through the parish priest or pastoral life director. Individuals cannot apply to the fund directly.

Applications are reviewed twice a year (normally spring and fall).

Funding is provided on a reimbursement basis. All original receipts for the project must be submitted before monies are released to the parish or school.

- 1. Financial need
- 2. Beneficial to more than one individual (directly or indirectly)
- 3. Canadian in content whenever possible
- 4. Diocesan in nature, that is:
 - Available to region or diocese
 - Shared in some form with others in the diocese
 - Educational in nature
 - Encouraging the development of lay ministry
 - Supportive of persons who have, and plan to continue to, work in the diocese

Ineligible for funding:

- Capital expenditures
- Parish missions
- Rental of facilities
- Personal retreats
- Salaries
