The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops Releases Open Letter to the Government and Message to the Catholic Faithful on Permitting Persons with Mental Illness access to Euthanasia/Assisted Suicide

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) has published two letters, an *Open Letter to the Government* and a *Message to the Catholic Faithful* on permitting persons with mental illness access to euthanasia/assisted suicide.

In these letters, they urge the government and the faithful to support initiatives to provide better palliative and mental health care, exhort them to remember the inviolable dignity of human life, and warn of the increasing number of cases of MAiD being used as a solution to problems of loneliness, poverty, and lack of access to care and support.
