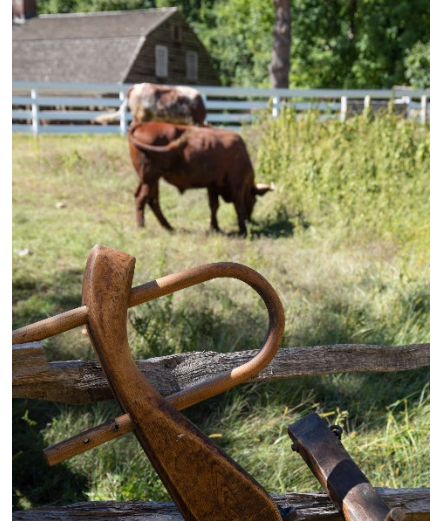

CCCB Release Pastoral Letter – Living as Catholics in the Public Square: Freedom of Religion and Conscience in Canada

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) has released a new pastoral letter regarding the state of freedom of religion and conscience in Canada, and the importance of Catholics and other faiths being allowed to practice their faith in the public square without fear of prejudice.

2023 Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) Religious Freedom Report

Aid to the Church in Need Canada (ACN) has released their Religious Freedom Report for 2023. The report has been published every 2 years by this international Catholic charity since 1999 and is the only non-governmental report on global religious freedom that covers all faiths.

This year's report has found that almost 63% of humanity lives in countries where people are not free to practice, express, or change their religion. In 47 of these countries, the situation has worsened since the last report, whereas only nine showed signs of improvement.

Fall 2023 Pastoral Care Training

The valuable and free Pastoral Care Outreach Training series will be offered online again this fall by the Diocese of Victoria Health Care Committee.

Nine sessions will be held via Zoom on Saturday mornings from 9:30 – noon, **starting on September 23 and running until November 25, 2023** (with no session on October 7 for Thanksgiving). Participants who attend all sessions will receive a Certificate of Completion. Participants will require a phone number and email address, a computer, tablet or smartphone with speakers, microphone and webcam, a reliable Internet connection and access to Zoom.

Whether you are a member of your parish Pastoral Care Team, an Extraordinary Minister of Communion, a member of the Knights of Columbus, CWL or St. Vincent de Paul, clergy or religious, caring for a family member, or someone attending as a personal undertaking, this training program is important. It will show why those who visit the sick are unique and how they can offer more than a friendly visit – they can be the hands and face of Christ to others. Bishop Gary Gordon of the Diocese of Victoria feels “it is important

to have parishioners trained at the ready to provide a caring and compassionate experience to those who are most in need.”

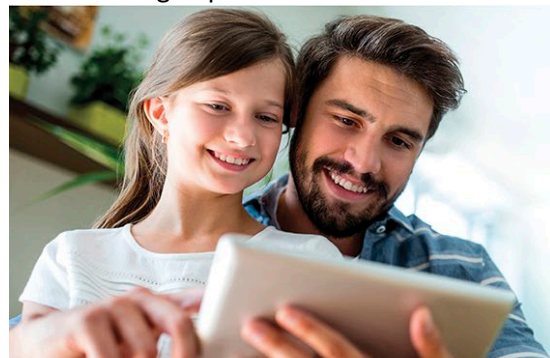
One Million Children Praying the Rosary for World Peace – Save the Date: October 18, 2023
