Called Together Diocesan Appeal and Healing and Reconciliation Appeal

The 2022-23 Appeal year has concluded and the final update is included in this week's Wednesday Weekly.

We managed to reach a little over 89% of our diocesan goal for Called Together, reaching 89.35% of our \$250,000 target. In addition to this, another \$111,047 was received from parishes that met their goal. Most of those funds have already been returned to the parishes for their own projects with the remainder to be distributed before the end of the month.

I am pleased to report that we received almost \$41,000 in our Healing and Reconciliation Appeal, bringing the total collected over two years to \$113,222.50, which is dedicated to supporting projects that promote healing and reconciliation.

The 2023-24 Appeal Year has already begun, and the active phase will take place this fall. We thank everyone for their continued support, both financially and through your prayers and sacrifices. Meeting the many needs throughout the entire diocese is a difficult challenge and we are so grateful to have the support of so many.

With sadness we must report that two Sisters of St. Joseph of Peterborough who served in the diocese for many years, Sr. Irene Baker and Sr. Dorothy Ryan, have returned to their community in Ontario. Fall 2023 Pastoral Care Training
