

The camp will take place during the Labour Day long weekend at Camp Morice on Stuart Lake, beginning at 3:00pm on Friday September 1st and concluding at 3:00pm on Sunday, September 3rd. For those who wish to stay until Monday the 4th, we will have a morning Mass, camp clean-up, and then hike Mount Pope.

Participants aged 7 and up are admitted; all minors must be accompanied by a chaperone. Bunkhouse accommodation is provided, or you may bring your own trailer or tent. Please let us know your preferred accommodation upon

registration. Participants must bring their own food, but meals may be prepared in common (more details on meals will be provided upon registration).

Early Bird registration is open until Friday, August 25th at \$40 per person for the first two people in one family, and \$10 per person for each member of the family after that.

Registrations received after the 25th are \$60 per person for the first two people in one family, and \$20 per person for each member of the family after that.

Payment is by cash or cheque on arrival. Registration closes on August 30th.

Fall 2023 Pastoral Care Training

The valuable and free Pastoral Care Outreach Training series will be offered online again this fall by the Diocese of Victoria Health Care Committee.

Nine sessions will be held via Zoom on Saturday mornings from 9:30 – noon, **starting on September 23 and running until November 25, 2023** (with no session on October 7 for Thanksgiving). Participants who attend all sessions will receive a Certificate of Completion. Participants will require a phone number and email address, a computer, tablet or smartphone with speakers, microphone and webcam, a reliable Internet connection and access to Zoom.

Whether you are a member of your parish Pastoral Care Team, an Extraordinary Minister of Communion, a member of the Knights of Columbus, CWL or St. Vincent de Paul, clergy or religious, caring for a family member, or someone attending as a personal undertaking, this training program is important. It will show why those who visit the sick are unique and how they can offer more than a friendly visit – they can be the hands and face of Christ to others.
