

Prince George Share Hope – January 23, 2024 Update



Since the invasion of Ukraine began in Feb 2022, Prince George Share Hope has helped to settle 301 displaced Ukrainians within 118 families, across our diocese. Financial support is one of many settlement supports offered by Prince George Share Hope.

We are approaching the third year of violence across Ukraine and we are currently experiencing a surge in applications from people looking to travel and settle here.
