*Bishop Jensen's Message on the Death of Pope Francis

April 21, 2025

To the Clergy, Religious and Faithful of the Diocese

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Early on Easter Monday in Rome, Pope Francis left this world and entered eternity.

His legacy will include a tireless emphasis on care for the marginalized in society and for migrants and refugees, a call to responsible stewardship of creation, promoting reconciliation and peace, and a commitment to the poor.

His Apostolic journey to Canada in 2022 (what he called "a penitential pilgrimage") was made to advance reconciliation and healing for those who attended the former Indian residential schools.


His emphasis on the missionary character of the Church promoted a deeper awareness among Catholics of their Baptismal vocation to be witnesses for Christ.

When he inaugurated the Jubilee Year last December, Pope Francis called us to be "pilgrims of hope." Now that his own pilgrimage has ended, we hope that he has met a merciful Judge and pray that he will be given a place among the saints.

O God, immortal shepherd of souls, look on your people's prayers and grant that your servant Pope Francis, who presided over your Church in charity, may, with the flock entrusted to his care, receive from your mercy the reward of a faithful steward. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

8 April 2025, Ottawa - The Catholic faithful across Canada are invited and warmly encouraged to celebrate **National Family and Life Week 2025** (NFLW) from Sunday, 11 May, 2025, to Sunday, 18 May, 2025. This annual event is an initiative of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, in collaboration with its Standing Committee for Family and Life, and the corresponding Office.

In the context of the Jubilee Year of Hope, the theme of this year's NFLW is "**Abound in hope**" inspired by Saint Paul's letter to the Romans: "*May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit*" (Romans 15:13).

A 2-minute **launch video** has been produced for wide distribution, along with a digital Pastoral Toolkit available for download by families, parishes, parish groups, ecclesial movements and associations, and Catholic schools.


2025 Diocesan Youth Conference – Registration Now Open!
