8 April 2025, Ottawa - The Catholic faithful across Canada are invited and warmly encouraged to celebrate **National Family and Life Week 2025** (NFLW) from Sunday, 11 May, 2025, to Sunday, 18 May, 2025. This annual event is an initiative of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, in collaboration with its Standing Committee for Family and Life, and the corresponding Office.

In the context of the Jubilee Year of Hope, the theme of this year's NFLW is "**Abound in hope**" inspired by Saint Paul's letter to the Romans: "*May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit*" (Romans 15:13).

A 2-minute **launch video** has been produced for wide distribution, along with a digital Pastoral Toolkit available for download by families, parishes, parish groups, ecclesial movements and associations, and Catholic schools.

2025 Diocesan Youth Conference – Registration Now Open!


