Called Together Diocesan Annual Appeal Final Report for 2024-25

Attached to this Wednesday Weekly is the final report for the 2024-2025 Appeal year. Altogether, we raised \$361,644 of which more than \$106,000 will go back to parishes that surpassed their portion of the diocesan goal.

We raised 85% of the diocesan goal of \$300,000, with just over \$255,000 going to support the smaller parishes, missions and ministries around the whole diocese. Thank you for your generosity.

While we've ended the 2024-2025 Appeal year, we have already begun the 2025-2026 Appeal with the same diocesan goal of \$300,000. Parishes have been asked to provide their parish project goal as soon as possible.

The active phase of this year's appeal will begin in mid-September.

World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly – July 27, 2025

The fifth World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated on July 27, 2025. This year's theme is "Blessed are those who have not lost hope." (cf. Sir 14:2).
