Called Together Diocesan Annual Appeal Update

With the current Canada Post strike, some appeal packages that were mailed out by the parishes may not have been received. If you need any additional packages for your parish, let us know and we'll try to have them ready for the pastors to take back with them next week.


Life Chain – October 5, 2025


The blessing will be followed by coffee and snacks. All are welcome to attend. Please find attached a poster for the event.
