Called Together Diocesan Annual Appeal Update

Attached is this week's update for our Appeal. Due to a change in how our software works, we're unable to report the total received until after it has been deposited. We hope to have that corrected for next week's update.

The amounts in the Total Pledged column are correct and represent each parish's progress to date. We've seen a number of parishes off to a roaring start, and we are current at just under 24% of our diocesan goal. Our thanks to everyone who has contributed already and to all those who are praying for the needs of the diocese.

With the Canada Post strike ongoing, some donations may be stuck in the mail and will not be reported until we receive them.
