Called Together Diocesan Appeal Update

We continue to see good support for our appeal. Thanks to your generosity, we're currently at almost two-thirds of the way to our diocesan goal of \$300,000 to support the smaller parishes, missions and ministries throughout the diocese. We are grateful for your continued help.

We now have three parishes that have met their total combined goals: St. Patrick's in McBride at 165% of their diocesan goal and 132% of their combined goal; St. Mary's in Prince George at 145% of their diocesan goal and 116% of their total combined goal; and Annunciation Parish in Prince Rupert at 184% of their diocesan goal and 102% of their total combined goal. In addition to these parishes, St. Joseph's in Vanderhoof has met their diocesan goal, sitting at just over 100%. St. Mary's in New Hazelton made a 30% leap towards their diocesan goal.

We've also seen big steps from Christ Our Saviour in Prince George, Christ the King in Kitimat, Notre Dame in Dawson Creek, Sacred Heart Parish in Terrace, St. Joseph's in Smithers, And St. Peter's in Mackenzie. Many parishes are close to their diocesan goal and well on their way to meeting parish goals as well.
